

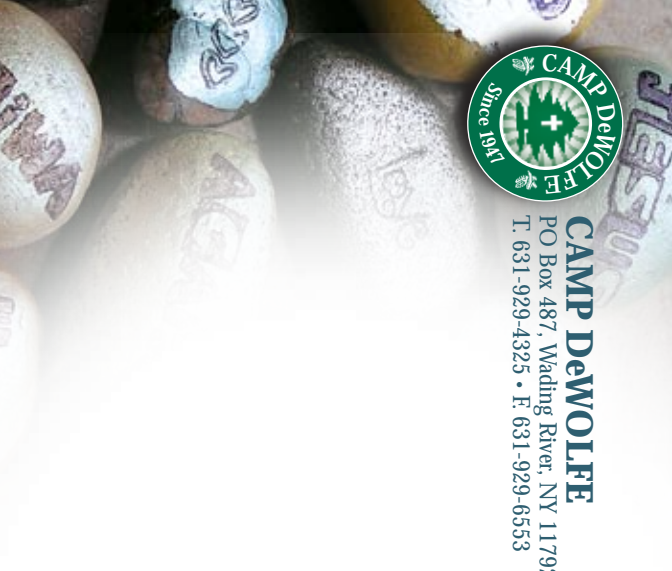


OUR MISSION

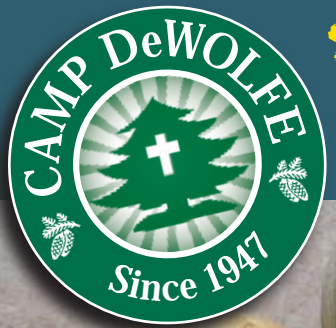
